Restorative failures have been attributed to a number of causes. Inadequate design of the restorative has been mentioned. However, failure may be traced to problems in the dental technique used in the restoration. Another common problem is the absence of a theoretical basis for restorative design. The first step in the evaluation of a restorative material is to place a proper definition on a restoration.

The proper definition is a restorative that is useful for the intended purpose. There should be no unnecessary additional component of the restorative. The proper definition includes the material, the method of application, and the technique used in the construction of the restoration. ## LABELING OF DENTAL STOCK While the practice of dentistry continues to be predominantly based on a "know-how" approach, there are increasing demands for a more scientific approach. In the field of dentistry, this approach to treatment has evolved to include techniques such as the labeling of dental stock. The purpose of such labeling is to enable dentists to maintain uniformity of treatment and to ensure that only quality dental material is used for a particular technique. The benefit of this approach is that it can also help to prevent the spread of infection. The most common labeling method is the labeling of materials in accordance with their color and shade, or in other words, the color of the natural tooth. In practice, this technique requires a color-matching ability on the part of the dentist and a regular supply of appropriate shade-related dental materials. This technique is not always the most practical because the dentist may have difficulty matching or because there may not be a suitable color-related product available. The technique of labeling stock in accordance with its quality and specifications may be considered the best method. This technique may involve the use of powder, liquid, or strip materials and may be based on a host of factors, including composition, physical properties, and
