1. Move the file to your TomTom/USB/SD card(s). 2. Download the latest version (2.5) from 3. Follow the instructions to install and you should find your new activator You no longer need to turn off your anti-virus in order to run the fastactivate app. . Oct 13, 2020 Update: I updated my post to include more details on how to set up FastActivate. Make sure your anti-virus is turned off before you install the app. . May 15, 2017 Make sure the phone must support the "TomTom APP File" (TPAF). I used a Samsung Note5, but FastActivate will work on most phones. Device support is greatly limited, so make sure that you select the correct version for your phone: . Apr 24, 2017 Updated for KitKat (and the reason why your device is not supported is because it's running Jellybean). . Mar 12, 2017 Updated for Marshmallow and HiSilo. . Feb 14, 2017 A couple of things: First, please update your phone (if you haven't done so already). I noticed that the item now supports Marshmallow and Android 5.1. If you don't have your phone up to date, you won't be able to run the app. . Jan 23, 2017 Tested again on Nexus 6P running Android 6.0.1 and it worked without installing the ttgo.bif Dec 15, 2016 Updated for KitKat (and the reason why your device is not supported is because it's running Jellybean). . May 19, 2016 Update -I have changed the target OS to KitKat. . Apr 13, 2016 Updated for Nexus 4 with KitKat. . Apr 13, 2016 Update for LG G3 "Spring/Honor": Apparently this smartphone is not supported by ttgo.bif; but it seems FastActivate can be installed/used. The app uses the storage on your device. Jul 20, 2016 Updated for Nexus 5 running KitKat. . Mar 22, 2016 Update for Nexus 4 with KitKat. . Mar 22, 2016 Update for LG G3 "Spring/Honor": Apparently this smartphone is not supported by ttgo.
