Category: Xbox Live GoldA campaign backed by Rupert Murdoch and Richard Branson to keep Scotland in the Union with the UK has released a survey suggesting the SNP is the most unpopular party in Scotland. The group, Scotland in Union, commissioned the poll from YouGov and published the results of an online survey of more than 1,300 people in Scotland to highlight the anti-independence campaign. The figure of 43 per cent who said they would not vote for the SNP in an election is only marginally higher than the 43 per cent who would not vote for the Scottish Labour party, the only other party in the Scottish Parliament. The poll also found that only 19 per cent of voters believe that Scotland's relationship with the rest of the UK is good or very good, a figure significantly higher than when the same question was asked in 2010. But the poll also found that support for Scottish independence has increased from 40 per cent to 45 per cent in the past four years. The poll found that 32 per cent of Scots believe that Scotland should be independent, with 26 per cent saying that it should not. A spokesman for Scotland in Union said: "Our survey suggests that a significant amount of Scots would like to see Scotland in the United Kingdom, but don't think that leaving would be a good thing for Scotland. "For too long, Scotland has been ignored by Westminster, with politicians in London telling Scots that they don't want us to have any say on our future. "Now more than ever, it is vital that we show Scotland that they have a strong voice in the European Union and it is vital that people believe we can influence decisions which affect Scotland's economy and way of life. "We need to restore the confidence of Scots that they can have a say on the future of their country." The survey found that the figures for voting in the 2014 independence referendum held in September will be replicated, with 62 per cent of voters agreeing that Scotland should have a referendum on its future with the rest of the UK. Sixty two per cent also believe that Scotland's relationship with the rest of the UK is bad or very bad. A spokesman for Scotland in Union said: "The SNP wants to break up our country and has made a promise to the electorate that there will be a referendum on independence after 2014."
