History of AutoCAD AutoCAD was originally developed by Arthur Budish in 1975 to compete with a number of other CAD programs which were already in use by his customers. Budish was joined by two others, Martin Nelsen and John Walker, who were employed by Autodesk to support and develop the new product. The technology underlying AutoCAD was written in the language "Caldera Lava" by Steve L. Kurtz. The code for the Lava language was later re-written in the language Fortran-77, which became the basis of the program. AutoCAD was first released in January 1982 and the initial version was shipped to over 4,000 CAD customers and was installed on over 2,000 computers within a month of its release. The same year, Version 1.0, was released for Windows and Macintosh. As its popularity grew, AutoCAD became more and more profitable, leading Autodesk to develop a version running on a PDP-11 minicomputer. This prototype version eventually became the basis of AutoCAD LT. In 1985, the version 2.0 of AutoCAD was released and it was the first version to include full vector drawing capability. In 1988, Autodesk released Autodesk Architecture, the first version of AutoCAD dedicated to architectural drafting. In 1991, version 3.0 was released. This version introduced the first mass customization model, allowing a user to mix and match parts from different features to create a new custom design. In 1993, version 4.0 was released and it introduced the parametric feature that enabled users to reuse existing parts, reducing design time. In 1994, version 4.1 was released and included features to enhance the draft environment. In 1995, Autodesk released AutoCAD LT, a low-cost version of AutoCAD with the ability to run on internal graphics boards and was priced from US\$149 to US\$599. AutoCAD LT used a simpler and less advanced version of the software and is still considered by many to be the original version of AutoCAD. In 1997, version 5.0 was released and it introduced the ability to customize AutoCAD functions and components. In 1998, version 5.1 was released and it introduced a set of new features including annotation of drawings, design information, sketches, additional drawing tools, enhanced file support, and an
