The Australian Christian Lobby has asked the Queensland Premier, Anna Bligh, to intervene in a dispute between the East Coast of Australia and a Balinese resort after the Queensland government granted the resort a 66-year lease on dormant coastal land. The land to be used by the Balinese temple was granted to the resort in July, and the Queensland government has declined to hear objections to the use of the land, even after the ABC reported that similar land in the same area was awarded to a different religious group last year. The Balinese temple at the centre of the dispute first applied to the federal government for a similar licence to the land in June last year, but the application was refused and the land was granted to the Baptist church of Poringba, which had put up a sign of its intention to build on the land and which decided to continue with its plans. "The fact that it only took the group a few months to build a temple to be able to go through this process indicates to me that it is really a government that is moving in the right direction," said Adrian Pederick, a spokesman for the East Coast Baptist Association.
